Propose a presentation for 10th June 2022!

Creative stories, lifestories, identity stories, the completion of an artwork...

Art studios role as a supporter for artistic work?

Intermediaries role for artist to become part of contemporary art context?

The meaning of lifestories in art?

Is there difference with ‘normal’ artists biographies?

Ethical questions?

Who is the one who tells the story?

Does the artist have a right to stand behind his/her work with his/her own name?

Why do we still have anonymity in outsider art? Is artistry public?

Alternative forms:

- Pecha Kucha -format
20 pictures 20 sec/picture, presentation altogether around 7 minutes + time for questions and discussion
- Artist presentations: free form (like performance) 5-10 minutes
- Short films up to 6 minutes
- presentations / lectures / workshop up to 20 minutes
